

HAJFL BOARD ELECTIONS

NOMINATIONS MEETING: Meeting will be set end of September to hear nominations from the membership. Will take place after a practice night, likely at Three Fires Cafeteria.

ELECTION NIGHTS: Two weeks after the nominations meeting, membership will be invited to vote for the board positions.

How does it work?

NOMINATIONS:

If you are interested in running for one of the board positions, you need to come to the nominations meeting. You will need someone to nominate you & be there to accept the nomination to be placed on a ballot.

- If nobody is nominated for a position, the person currently holding the position retains the position, or if they choose to not accept a second term, the position will remain open.
- Football parents can only nominate commissioners for their own color.
- You must be present at the meeting to be nominated, and accept the nomination. For those nominees not able to be present, a letter of acceptance in writing will be sufficient, but still has to be turned in for you by a friend at the meeting.
- If you accept the nomination and are running against someone for your position you can submit a letter to the members: 1) introducing yourself, and 2) stating the reason(s) you're running. This letter will appear in the following newsletter. Candidates will need to email their letters to howelljrfootball@yahoo.com .date TBD.

VOTING:

- Voting is done in front of the pods. You will check in at the table, fill out your ballot (s) and return them to the ballot box.
- HAJFL President and board members will administer the voting, and will be counting the votes. If there is conflict of interest due to contested positions, LCAJFL president will be asked to administer the voting.
- Each football player & cheerleader represents one vote. (three kids in the league means you get three votes.)
- All parents vote for the Executive Board Positions; President, Vice President, Treasurer and Secretary.
- All parents vote for Field Director and Equipment Director.
- Only Football parents will vote for their color football commissioners. (cheer parents can't vote for football commissioners). Instructional parents will vote for their color's commissioner. If Rookies and not associated with any color, they will not vote for commissioners.
- Only Cheerleader parents vote for Cheer Director and Assistant Cheer Director.
- Results will be tallied by the president and vice president and announced in the following newsletter.
- All Board terms run from Jan 1 – Dec 31.
- Job descriptions are attached for all positions. Acceptance of the nominations assumes you've read and agreed to the job description for your position. Disclaimer: this description does not include everything!
- Note: According to 2006 Board decision: due to commitment the board members make to the league over the whole year, Board members children play for free. This only applies if the board member attends 80% of all board functions and fulfills the positions' responsibilities.
